The first day of the school will be dedicated to a workshop on CCUS.

From 10:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., students will attend lecturers on these important technologies for mitigating climate change reducing atmospheric CO₂ emissions, as well as on the mission and challenges of ECCSEL-ERIC (European Carbon Dioxide Capture and Storage Laboratory Infrastructure), the European initiative aiming to create a network of top quality research laboratories dedicated to the development of CCUS technologies.

Special attention will be given to ECCSEL-NatLab Italy and the research activities carried out using the natural $\rm CO_2$ venting of the Panarea volcanic complex to test new high-tech instruments and monitoring programs in CCUS projects.
